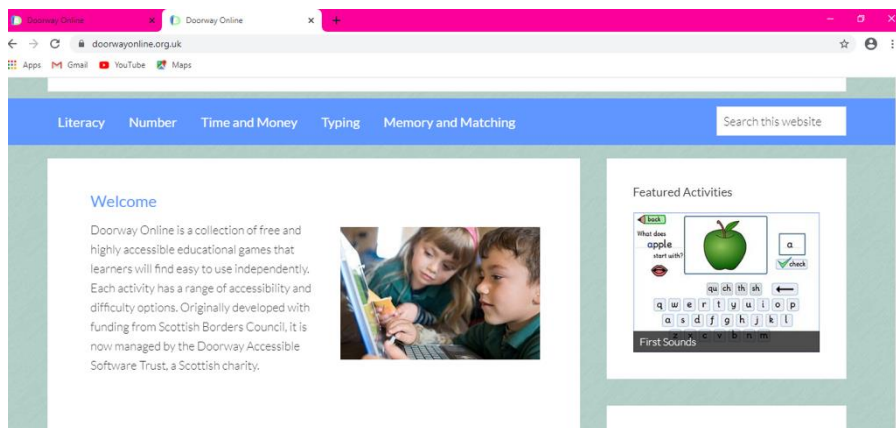


Doorway Online User Guide

Literacy

- First Phonics

Phonics is a way of understanding how letters look and sound. This activity helps you to see what letters make what sound, for example, *ch th* and *ay*, as well as single letter sounds like *a,m* and *s*.

- Letter & Number Formations

This allows you to trace and follow how letters and numbers are written. This will help recognise difference in capital and lower-case letters and how these letters and numbers should be written.

- Speller 2

Speller follows the look, say. Cover and write approach using knowledge of how letters sound and what letters together make certain sounds.

Numeracy

- Odd and Even

Practical activities to establish the essential concept of Odd and Even.

- Up to 10

Using images and spoken word to help recognise number patterns and counting to 10.

- Number Table

Practise sequencing numbers by placing counters on a table.

- Count Me In

Reinforce learners' understanding of two-digit numbers and their relationships.

- Add and Subtract to 10

Practise addition and subtraction in the range 1-10, using on-screen number blocks. Number Bonds and subtraction can be reinforced and tested.

- Add and Subtract to 100

This uses animated tens and units 'blocks' to give learners experiences from place value to the full skill of addition and subtraction.
