# Graphics and wording

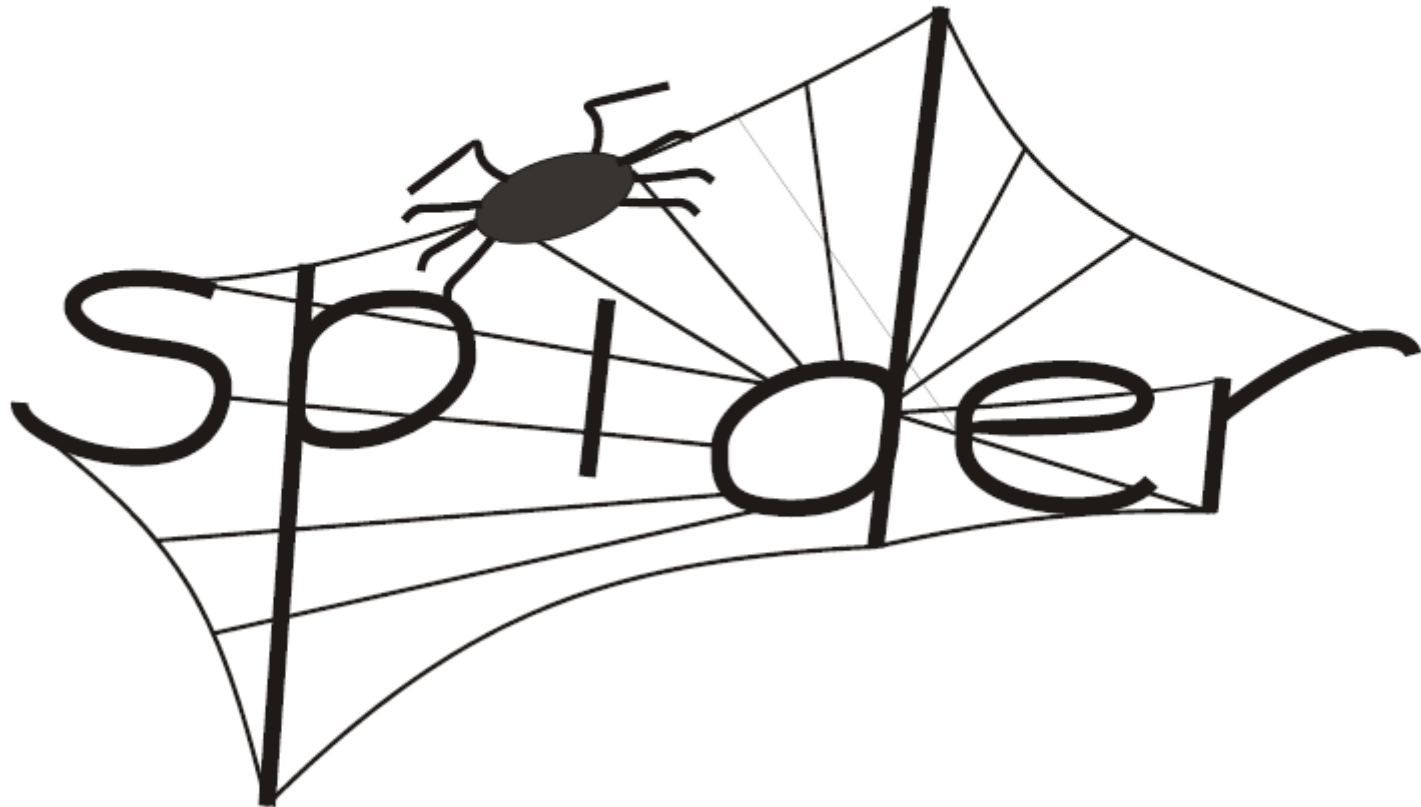
The Overall Shape of the Word

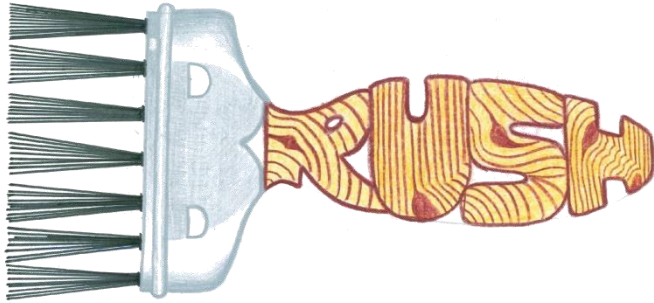

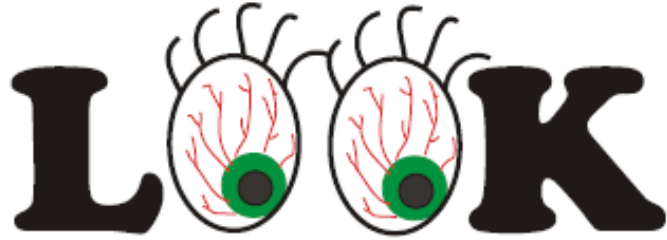
