# Manual Sketching

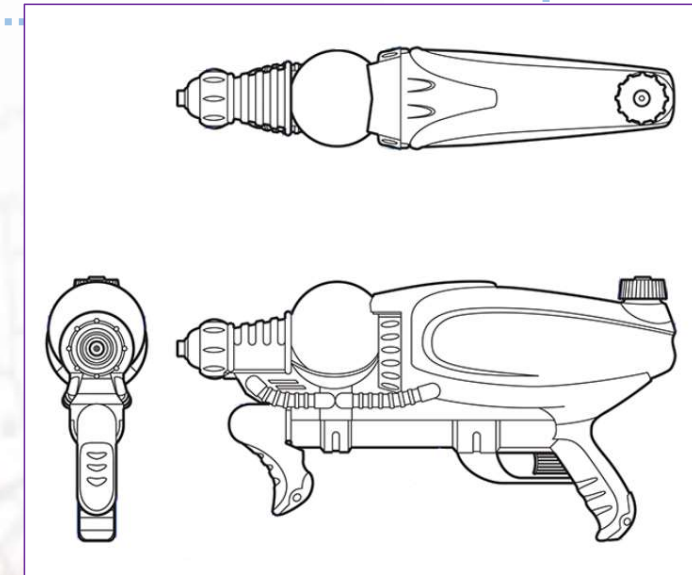
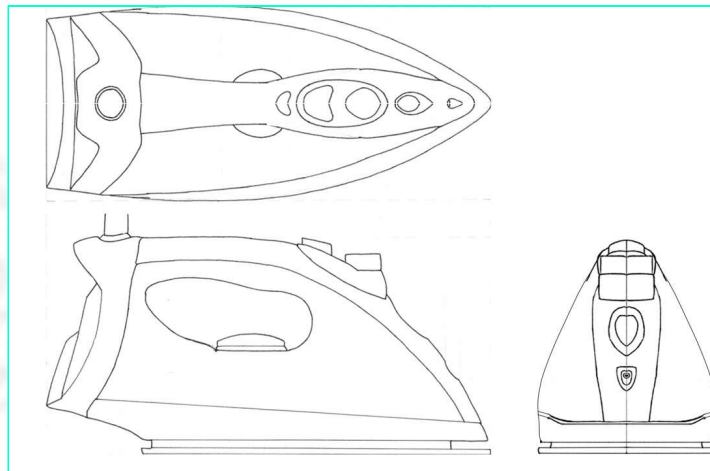
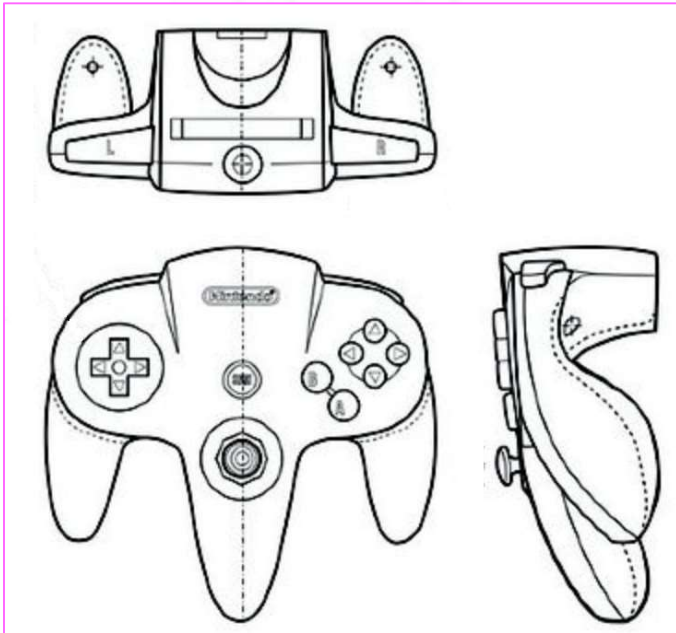
Last weeks task was a lot of work so this week will be a bit more relaxed.
