
## Practical Woodwork: Week 4 Cutting Lists and Sequence of Operations





In class we have completed a few exercises to practice reading information from a working drawing and using that information to create a cutting list.

Task: I have attached a 2 project images and sizes. Use the information from the working drawing to create an appropriate cutting list and sequence of operations









Task2: Complete the cutting list shown below.
